Have a wonderful summer, and please reach out if there is anything you need. We are here for you year-round.

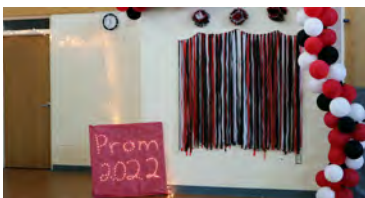

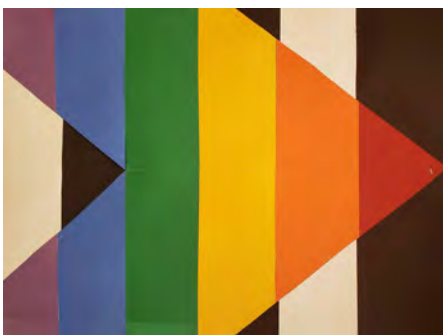


Prom Time!
