The mission of the program is to help DCF families thrive by finding homes in safe, nurturing neighborhoods, achieving economic independence, developing healthy relationships, and providing their children with a stable and caring home environment..

## SERVICES INCLUDE:

- Housing subsidy and/or rental housing to help families achieve reunification/preservation.
- Case management services that focus on financial support, employment, housing, transportation, family support and child care; and overall health and behavioral health services.
- An Individualized Service Plan (ISP) to meet the unique needs of families.
- Referrals, advocacy, crisis intervention and counseling services, as needed.
- Coordination of substance abuse treatment such as Relapse Prevention, Children's Services, Education Support and Parenting Training.

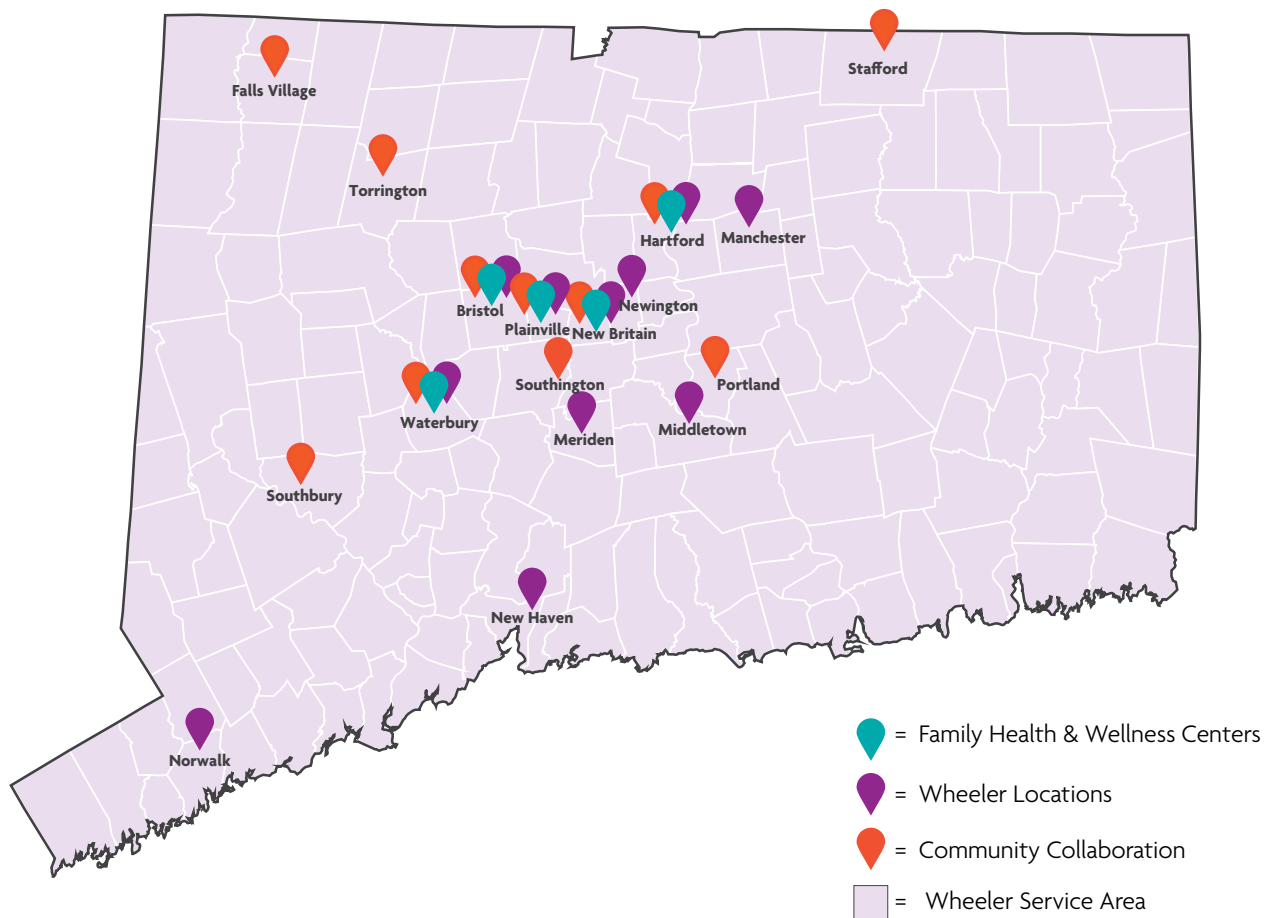
