# THE BASIC NEEDS FUND

## 100% Donor-Supported 0% Overhead

Wheeler's Basic Needs Fund addresses environmental and social factors that interfere with a patient's health and well-being, but which are not addressed through their own resources or other programs. It's benefited more than 8,500 patients since 2018.



The fund is **wholly donor-supported**, has **0% administrative overhead**, and allows our community health workers and staff to immediately and flexibly address conditions that might lead to poor health outcomes. It addresses the basic needs of life such as: food, transportation, clothing, shelter, medications, or other items. The stories of how it changes lives are countless...

One patient was **ready to start a construction job**, but **could not afford boots**. Through the Basic Needs Fund, he was able to buy work boots, start the job, and support his family.

"I need help for a family who is without heat while they're waiting for the landlord to fix it. They have a limited number of blankets in the house. I would like to purchase three heavy blankets for them."
