- A transdisciplinary team approach that includes a full continuum of educational, mental health, psychiatry, speech, occupational therapy, and health and wellness services in one location
- Specialized programming, such as community-based learning, gender-responsive classrooms, transition services, and pre-vocational programming
- Consistent communication with home school districts and families to ensure coordination of care
- Trauma-informed relational approach to address the needs of students in the areas of emotional and behavioral regulation, social skill development, self-esteem building, and decision-making
- Short-term diagnostic placements and multidisciplinary evaluations to provide an individualized assessment of student needs
- Linkages with other programs offered across the Wheeler continuum of services
